REQUIREMENTS IN ORDER TO WORTHILY RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION

Receiving Holy Communion expresses and deepens our union with the Lord. However, when we knowingly and deliberately commit a serious sin, this destroys the bond of supernatural life between us and the Lord. In such cases we need to repent and avail ourselves of the Sacrament of Reconciliation from a Catholic priest, before we can worthily receive Holy Communion again. St. Paul wrote, *"Therefore whoever eats the bread and drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner shall be guilty (of sin) ... a person must examine himself "(first)1 Cor 11:27-29.* Early Christians also witness this was the practice of the early Church. The Didache, written in 70 A.D. says, "But first (before Holy Communion) make a confession of your (serious) faults, so that your sacrifice may be pure."

Some sins that exclude one from receiving Holy Communion until a good sacramental confession has been made to a Catholic priest are:

- A. Obstinate and knowingly rejecting a defined dogma of the Church such as the Church's teaching on the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist, or belief in the Divinity of Christ or the belief in the dogmas proclaimed by the Church about Mary, etc.
- B. Obstinate and knowingly rejecting or acting against a definitive moral teaching of the Church such as the evil of abortion, euthanasia, same sex marriage, in vitro fertilization, artificial contraception, or sterilization for the purpose of avoiding pregnancy.
- C. Deliberately missing Mass on a Sunday or a Holy Day of Obligation (which is Christmas and January 1st) without a just reason.
- D. A Catholic who has married outside the Church or is living common law.
- E. Any impure thought or action fully consented to with others or by oneself
- F. Pornography
- G. Drunkenness, gluttony, or use of drugs for non-medicinal purposes.
- H. Seriously harming the reputation of others through gossip or slander.
- I. Refusing to forgive or deliberately harbouring hatred towards another person.
- J. Taking what does not belong to us or failing to give others what is theirs in significant ways.
- K. Greed that unreasonably seeks to possess what belongs to or is needed by others.
- L. Formal perjury or lies that mislead other in serious matters.
